



MAVERICKS ATHLETES' CODE OF CONDUCT

The following is a description of the Mavericks Athlete Code of Conduct. Each swimmer is expected to follow the Code of Conduct. Signing at the bottom means you agree to live up to this code in order to show respect to your teammates, coaches, and the sport.

1. Any actions that interfere with a swimmer's participation and/or enjoyment of swimming with the Mavericks team will not be tolerated.
2. Inappropriate words or actions towards any Swimmer, Coach, Parent or Swim Official will not be tolerated.
3. Disrespect or destruction of the pool area, swimming equipment, or competition facilities will not be tolerated.
4. Be on time and be prepared for practice.
5. Be respectful of others and their property.
6. No food or gum on deck during practice. Sports drinks and/or water are allowed.

The following consequences will be enforced when necessary.

Step 1. The swimmer will be spoken to about the issue.

Step 2. The swimmer will be given a time out, and the coach will discuss why the swimmer is not responding to the warning. The coach may also try to determine if there are outside factors (bad day at school, health, trouble at home, etc.) The coach will listen to the swimmer and try to communicate firmly and calmly that the behavior must change in order to continue practicing.

Step 3. If the swimmer is not responding and is not showing any improvement in behavior, the swimmer will be asked to get out of practice for the day.

Step 4. If there are behavioral issues that develop with a swimmer that can not be resolved, the Head coach will contact the family for a meeting.
